THE COWICHAN VALLEY AND COWICHAN SECONDARY SCHOOL

- The academy is located in Duncan, British Columbia
- The warmest region of Canada, open to outdoor training twelve months of a year
- Cowichan Secondary enrolls over 800 students from Grades 10-12
- Offers high level academic courses in Math and Science, unique electives in computer studies, robotics, forensic science, applied skills, fine arts, outdoor recreation and a full range of other athletic programming
- Many of our graduates attend top Canadian universities, some on scholarship.

PROGRAM INFORMATION

- Open to all students of all ability levels entering Grades 10-12
- Students will take two classes each semester in the areas of Principles of Sport, Athletic Leadership and Rugby. These credit courses will apply to student's graduation plans.
- Rugby specific skills training in combat, scrimmage, speed, weights
- Sport performance seminars in leadership, nutrition, time management, mental performance, effective communication, conflict resolution, recovery, team building, post-secondary planning



PATHWAYS & PARTNERSHIPS

LOCAL CLUB RUGBY

The majority of athletes, both local and out-of-town play for the Cowichan Piggies. Partnering with the Cowichan Piggies has provided athletes with further development and has helped integrate them with the local community. The additional players has also assisted the Piggies in fielding teams, especially with the return to play after the pandemic. MacDowell Rugby is proud to partner with Thunder Rugby to help promote rugby in Indigenous communities and the success of Indigenous athletes.





POST-SECONDARY OPPORTUNITIES

MacDowellRugby has connections with 50+ universities across Canada, including the University of Victoria, University of British Columbia, Queens University and many more. These partnerships assist in helping athletes pursue their dreams of playing rugby at the university level. By connecting student-athletes and university coaches, MacDowellRugby helps create. conversations and relationships, which will assist athletes in chasing their dreams of playing at a



post-secondary institution and even getting academic and athletic scholarships. This year alone, we have twelve Grade 12 students eligible to apply for athletic scholarships at their university of choice. The academy anticipates student athletes receiving between \$250,000 - \$500,000 in athletic scholarships to help fund their university education,; helping to remove financial barriers for many and get our student athletes one step closer to achieving their goals and dreams.

PROFESSIONAL OPPORTUNITIES

MacDowellRugby has recently partnered with Major League Rugby's Toronto Arrows, providing a pathway for athletes to pursue rugby at the professional level. Additionally, the academy also has ties with the new Premier Rugby Sevens league for those wishing to play 7's at the professional level.

PAYMENT POLICY

- Applications will be processes when the application fee and homestay application fee are paid.
- Half of remaining fees due upon receipt of letter of acceptance.
- Second half of remaining fees due October 31, 2022.
- Homestay fees are paid to MacDowellRugby and remitted to the host family on a monthly schedule.

REFUNDPOLICY

- In the event that a student decides to leave MacDowellRugby Academy, no fees will be refunded. Application fees will be retained to cover administrative expenses. The following refund policy will apply for each student:
 - Within 60 days of acceptance into the program 75% refund.
 - Withdrawal by September 30, 2022 50% refund
 - No refund for withdrawal after September 30, 2022.
- No refund if student is in violation of the program or Cowichan Secondary Student Codes of Conduct
